The walk is fully waymarked and a detailed route description will be given to walkers when they check in at registration on the day of the walk.

The walk takes in some of the most spectacular scenery in the South Pennines and in walking terms is described as moderately difficult. It is approximately 23 miles long, including the optional Widdop/Gorple reservoir loop. The walk includes the beautiful wooded valleys of Hardcastle Crag and the commanding heights of moors above the Luddenden Valley.

The Walk is split into four sections each of which ends on a road to facilitate a checkpoint and refreshment stop. Transport is also available at these points should you wish to terminate your walk.
